Biography

Dr. Jared Carbone is an Associate Professor at the University of Calgary where he is affiliated with the Department of Economics and the Energy and Environmental Systems Group at the Institute for Sustainable Energy, Environment and Economy. My research focuses primarily on evaluating the economy-wide impacts of environmental policies. He has written on the challenges of developing effective regulatory responses to global warming in open economies, how communities respond to natural disasters, and a variety of problems in which changes in environmental quality and human health can interact with the market economy in unexpected ways. Dr. Carbone completed a PhD in Economics from University of Colorado at Boulder in 2003 where he worked under the mentorship of Thomas F. Rutherford. Subsequently, he worked with V. Kerry Smith as a post-doctoral fellow at the Center for Environmental and Resource Economics Policy at North Carolina State University from 2003 to 2005. He was an Assistant Professor at Williams College from 2005 to 2007 before moving to the University of Calgary.
